## Objective:

- Students will complete the drawing by connecting the numbers in the correct order.
- Students will recognize how hard they need to press on the paper as they improve their writing skills.

## Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Little Building, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, discuss how a Dot to Dot activity might have been good for Boomer to help him learn to have a plan for his next move, so he could be learn to be accountable. Then have the students do the activity.

### Assessment:

Students will understand the importance of starting with a particular number and moving forward by connecting to the following number. They'll improve their handwriting skills. They'll also learn how to create shapes, and focus their pencil.
