Objective:

- Students will practice the correct use of capitalization, allowing them to memorize and store the information for future purpose.

Materials:

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Little Building, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form in which students will provide the correct capitalization for each of the sentences.

Assessment:

Students will demonstrate the understanding of standard capitalization when writing. They'll use their knowledge to correctly punctuate people's names, titles of people, the first word in a sentence, dates, and names of businesses.
