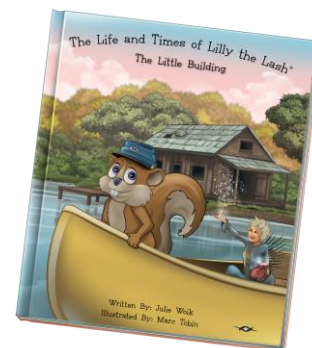


The Little Building

Lesson #5



Age:
3rd Grade

Objective:

- Students will explore the characters, plot, setting, and conflict to get a strong understanding of the storyline.
- Students will create a new cover design for the book they are reading to demonstrate comprehension.
- Students will illustrate to communicate their ideas and information effectively.

Materials:

The Little Building by Julie Woik

Pencils, Colored Pencils, Markers, and Colors

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *The Little Building*, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form in which students will use their interpretation of the storyline to create their idea of the best suited cover for the book.

Assessment:

Students will use their knowledge of the work of literature combined with their creativity, to design a new book cover. They will produce a book cover based on their opinion of what took place within the story.
